


Please note, this is a document containing only new functionnalities we have made in the past few months for better user experience.

1- Dashboard page

This is the new Dashboard Page






- New block « Vessel need your attention » means vessel which have some analysis in urgent and caution only
- New block « Over 6 months without analysis » which refers to vessels that have not received analysis for more than 6 months
- 3 Possibility to create sample
- 4 New block « Statistics » with some graphs
 - Sample status : Shows you the sample that are currently sent or in progress
 - Analysis status: Shows you the number of all your reports with their status

2- Vessel page 1/3

This is the new vessel page. It will be sorted by default by newest sample date.






- The user will have the possibility to sort by newest sample date, oldest sample date, by alphabetically..
- He can also filter by status, show only new reports, or sort by equipment family by using this new block.

2- Vessel page 2/3


Here some examples



Example 1: The user has filtered by « Urgent » status and we can see displayed the « VESSEL F ». It is the only one that has an analysis in urgent which belongs to « other equipement » family.




Example 2: The user has filtered by « Oldest sample » we can see displayed several vessels with no new report for a while...



2- Vessel page 3/3






Example 3: The user has filtered by family equipement « Other equipment » and has chosen the urgent status.

He will see only vessels that have some analyses in urgent in the « Other Equipment » family.

2)A- Vessel page – Overview

On this page you can see an overview of your vessel.





You will see for your vessel:


- Number of equipement with their status

 Here you can see total number of equipement with their status...
- Possibility to create your sample

 Here you have the possibility to create your sample directly for this specific vessel
- Equipment need your attention (Urgent and Caution)
 Here you can see all equipment which are some analysis in urgent and caution
- Equipment without analysis for more than 6 months
 Here you can see all Sample points that have not received analysis for more than 6 months..
- Statistic section :
 - Sample status: Status of your samples that are currently sent or in progress for this vessel
 - Analysis status: Total number of reports made during the current year with their statuses for this vessel
 - Analysis by equipement category: Number of analyses by equipment category which have been made for this vessel.

2)A- Vessel page – Overview – No analysis for over 6 months






In this case all your analyses are considered as « no status » because the last analysis was performed more than 6 months.

Even if you have some analysis in urgent and caution, they will not be displayed in this area because they are more than 6 months old.

You will find all your analyses made in the section « Over 6 months without analysis »

2)B- Vessel page – Equipment page






- 1 You have possibility to filter by equipement family.
- You have the possibility to use additional filters for see only sample points that are in urgent for exemple...
- By clicking on the « + » you can create a sample. By clicking on the arrow you will be redirected to analysis page.

2)C- Vessel page – *Analysis page*






- Customer and vessel name.


Step 1: Vessel

- Select Sample point




Step 2 : Sample

Step 3 : Oil condition


- Select oil

3)Form create sample 2/2


Step 4: Validation
